I. GENERAL INFORMATION

II. PARTICIPANTS

All athletes that are selected by the respective ITKF National Federations to compete must fulfill the following conditions:

- 1. They must be current member of national federation in a good standing of the ITKF.
- 2. Age in agreement with their competition category.
- 3. They must know, fully understand and be able to compete in accordance with the ITKF competition rules.
- 4. They must be free of any physical or mental handicap that might cause a breach of the ITKF rules.
- 5. All **KUMITE**, **KO-GO** and **FUKU-GO** athletes are obliged to wear the official ITKF **KUMITE GLOVES** in accordance with ITKF rules. For hygienic reasons gloves cannot be shared between athletes. Mouth (tooth) guards are also mandatory to be worn. (Breast-protection for women, groin protector for men is optional, but recommended safety equipment)
- 6. They must have his/her own international traveling insurance and also personal accident insurance issued by their respective National Federations.
- 7. They must belong to a National Federation which is a full and paid-up member of the ITKF including the year 2025.
- 8. Only individuals holding a valid ITKF Certified Judge and Coaches Qualification and properly registered with the Tournament Controlling Body will be allowed to represent and coach athletes during the competition.
- 9. They must present Medical Release and International Health Insurance to Medical Emergencies.
- 10. All countries must bring their national anthem one national flags.

INDIVIDUAL KATA:

Groups **Children A-C**: eliminations - flag system, final (last 4 athlete by points) Groups **Cadets A/B** and **Juniors A/B**: eliminations - flag system, final (last 4 athlete by points)

TYPE OF KATA (individual and team):

Group A: elimination: Taikyoku, Heian 1-2-3; (The kata is run according to the decision of the Kanza)

Group B: elimination: Heian 1-2-3-4-5; (The kata is run according to the decision of the Kanza)

Group C: elimination: Heian 1-2-3-4-5 Tekki 1; (The kata is run according to the decision of the Kanza)

Final-Kata: free

Team Kata: Each team will be composed of 3 contestants (1 athlete can be from the younger group). No Bunkai.

KIHON:

From natural stance **must step back** with Gedan-Barai and start techniques from left (Hidari) stance! <u>4 steps forward</u> with the technique and <u>4 steps back</u> with the combination. <u>Kiai on the last series of techniques</u>.

1. AN ATHLETE CAN PARTICIPATE IN INDIVIDUAL CATEGORIES ONLY IN HIS AGE CATEGORY. IF HE PARTICIPATES IN TEAM CATEGORY FOR AN OLDER AGE GROUP, HE CANNOT PARTICIPATE IN THE SAME TEAM CATEGORY IN HIS AGE GROUP!

Example: one cadet athlete can participate in individual categories for cadets. He can participate in team kata for juniors. In this case he cannot be part of team kata cadets.
